Used for Wound cultures, MRSA Nares, In-patient Strep A
screens, and clinic wet preps





Dual swab for skin and soft tissue MRSA/MRSA PCR testing, and Strep B PCR testing

Used for Nasal pharyngeal collection of Influenza A, B (screen or PCR); RSV; Respiratory Panel, COVID19 PCR

Used for Non-Nasopharyngeal collection
of virus cultures and viral PCR testing
(Mycoplasma, Ureaplasma, HSV)
